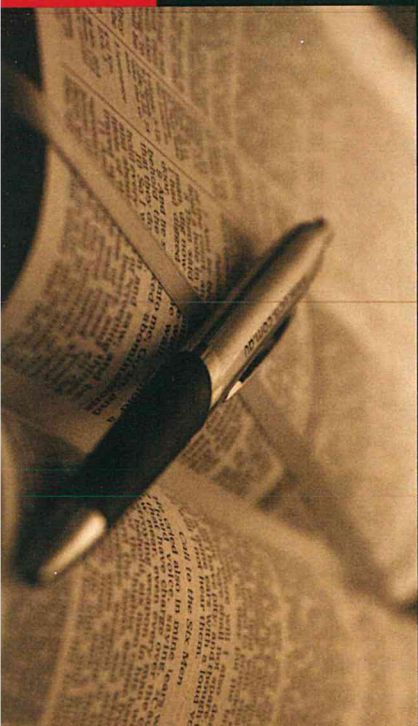

THE COURSE

We use worldviews to observe, understand and make sense of life. They are the lens through which we look to help us interpret what we see, hear and read. They shape what we believe. Our beliefs determine our decisions, choices, and responses....in short our whole lives.

Our aim is to help equip people of all ages and backgrounds to understand the Christian faith in the face of present-day doubts and questions.

We meet on Saturdays over the course of the academic year in 3:16 House, Portrush. These study days are full of great teaching from expert tutors and complemented by practical seminars and discussion sessions.
